

End precarious contract faculty jobs in Ontario colleges

70% of faculty in Ontario colleges are contract workers. These teachers, librarians and counsellors have no job security, lower wages and fewer benefits than their full-time colleagues. Yet, they must have the same qualifications and do the same work.

Students in Ontario colleges deserve a quality education yet, the majority of their faculty are not able to meet with them individually or participate meaningfully in developing and guiding the curriculum because of precarious working conditions.

College contract faculty deserve equal pay for equal work and college students deserve a quality education.

We, the undersigned, call on Premier Kathleen Wynne and the Minister of Advanced Education and Skills Development, Deb Matthews, to end precarious contract jobs and provide decent, fair working conditions for all college faculty.
